#### PIONEER PROVING HUGELY POPULAR WITH ENTRIES OVER 70% SOLD

Organisers of The Pioneer Mountain Bike Stage race are thrilled with the response to the new format for the event, set to return in November 2018, with entries already over 70% sold and exceeding numbers from the previous two editions of the multistage mountain bike event.

Race Director Bec Williams has taken huge confidence from the entries so far, but also the feedback following the announcement that the event would return this year in a six-day format.

"It was our goal to ensure the long-term sustainability of the event, without losing the characteristics that made the first two editions so special. Demand for entries and the conversations we have had with riders directly and online have given complete backing for the changes we have made, it is going to be a very special event in November this year, one that is fresh for returning riders, and a stunning challenge for everyone."

Amongst the changes is a Queenstown start and finish to the event, with riders now taking in six days of pedaling with 450km of riding in total. Williams says the event will be just as challenging as ever though.

"One thing that was made clear was riders did not want us to soften this event too much, they want and expect to ride over terrain that will take them to their limits, and with over 15,000 metres of climbing, this course certainly ticks that box."

Entries are coming in from all around the world too, with 21 countries represented, with the biggest numbers coming from Australia, United States, and Singapore, while of course New Zealand is the largest nation of riders.

Williams says those numbers are only going to increase, with a series of information roadshow events about to take place in Australia and New Zealand.

"We expect demand on entries to increase over the next month and urge anyone considering entering to do so now to avoid possible disappointment. We know from the level of registrations for information, that many more people are considering the race, or in fact have already made the commitment to race but haven't yet completed the entry process."

The information evenings will provide riders or prospective riders with an overview of the event, including course information, technical advice, gear requirements, advice for supporters, and importantly contain a lengthy question and answer session when anything can be tabled of the organisers. At many of the evenings these questions will also be answered by riders who have already experienced The Pioneer and can share their stories.
